Ministries to the natives did not go as well as he had hoped. In addition, he was hurt with the failed relationship. He returned to England with heart, price, spirit, and faith all broken.

But that eventually led him to so-called "Aldersgate experience," when Wesley felt deep in his heart that, despite his sinfulness and imperfect nature, God loved him and embraced him all

along. All he had to do was to receive the grace God offers and to live each day in grateful response to such amazing love. This realization changed him forever – and almost three hundred years later, United Methodist today are known to be the "people of
